Opening a selection test for the recruitment of three thousand (3,000) teachers as part of the fifth phase of the third program of contracting Nursery and Primary School Teachers to be sent to government nursery and primary schools for the 2023 session.

- <u>Article 1</u>. -: (1) This decree opens a selection test for the recruitment of three thousand (3,000) Primary and Nursery School Teachers for the benefit of public primary schools in Cameroon.
- (2) The written tests of the said test will take place on Saturday, **February 03**, **2024**, in all the Head Quarters of the Regions.
- <u>Article 2. -</u>: (1) The call for applications for this test is indexed to the needs of needy schools (job posting). Each candidate chooses a school in which he wishes to work and composes in the regional composition center that houses the area that was the subject of his choice.
- (2) However, in the event that the quota allocated to a school is reached, the Ministry of Basic Education may have to assign the successful candidates to another needy school in the same region, which has not registered applicants.
- <u>Article 3.</u> -: The distribution of places as well as the quotas by Region and by department are according to the needs expressed by the target schools mentioned in Article 2.
- <u>Article 4. :</u> The list of needy schools mentioned above will be previously published by the Ministry of Basic Education and each candidate must specify, in a letter of motivation included in the file, the school for which he will submit to the test.

### Article 5. -: CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED TO MAKE AN APPLICATION.

Cameroonians of both sexes who meet the following conditions may apply:

- a) Be 40 years of age at most on 31 December 2023.
- b) Hold a CAPIEMP issued no later than 2018.
- <u>Article 6.</u> -: The selection test is open to any person holding CAPIEMP 2018 and to all holders of previous CAPIEMP, having not taken part or not in the previous phases of the third recruitment program. Interested parties shall be required to submit an application file, the composition of which shall be laid down in Article 7.

#### Article 7. -: COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILES.

- (1) The application files that will be received in full in the Regional Delegations of Basic Education no later than **12 January 2024**, deadline of rigor, will include the following documents:
  - a) A stamped request addressed to the Minister of Basic Education;
  - b) Two passport photos (4X4 format);
  - c) A certified copy of the birth certificate;
  - d) Two certified copies of the CAPIEMP or Teacher's Grade One Certificate;
  - e) An unstamped photocopy of the professional diploma;
  - f) A certified photocopy of the National Identity Card;
  - g) A bulletin n°3 of the extract from the criminal record (less than 03 months old);
  - h) A medical examination bulletin;
  - i) A civil status information sheet;



- j) A data sheet of the candidate, the model of which will be collected in the services of each Regional Delegation of the Ministry of Basic Education;
- k) A commitment on honor to serve in his position of assignment for 5 years;
- A letter of motivation from the candidates specifying the needy school chosen;
- m) A copy of a certified marriage certificate (if any).
- n) A certificate of residence in the requested region.
- o) An envelope, in A4 format, stamped at the candidate's address.
- (2) Any incomplete or late application will be rejected;
- (3) Candidates submit their applications exclusively in the Region which houses the chosen school and whose capital is necessarily their composition centre;
  - (4) All composition centres are bilingual.

<u>Article 8. -</u>: The written tests of the selection test will take place according to the table below:
